Julie Clark won the **ladies 18-hole comp on Wednesday.** She finished with 35 points and was followed by Helen Edwards with 29.

Helen Tickle took out **Wednesday's ladies 9-hole comp** with 19 points, 1 point ahead of Bronwyn Thorley.

The Thursday 12-hole comp was back in action after time off because of Christmas and New Year's Days. Rod Jones was the winner with 25 points followed by Herby Cox, 24, and Pierre Pudig, 23. Chris Bell was nearest the pin and Herb Cox won the putting.

Bronwyn Thorley took out **Friday's ladies 9-hole comp** with 20 points, 1 point ahead of Helen Lockwood.

Rowan Butler won **Friday's Tradies comp** with 30 points. Jai Tasker was runner-up with 26.

Sandy Cook won **Saturday's ladies stableford** in a countback with Ange Driscoll. Each finished with 36 points.

67 players took to the course on Saturday to play a stableford with a Super 6 side comp as well. David Hawker had a brilliant round to win when he finished with 71 off the stick and 43 points using his handicap of 8. He had a bogey on the 1st hole and then parred every hole for the rest of the round. Todd Leadbetter and Robert Reynolds were next with 41's. They were followed by Rocky Roger, 40, Fergus Roger, 39 with an eagle on the 15th, James Roger and Ashley Walters, 38, and the 4 players with 37. Ben Campbell, David Hawker and Andrew Iskov were best in the Super 6 - each finished with 15 points.

Sunday's medley stableford was won by Rocky Roger. His 42 points was 4 points clear of second placed James Davis. Steve Glover was another 2 behind on 36.
