Helen Tickle was best in the **2nd round of the ladies championship on Wednesday**. She finished with nett 72. Jan Frater was next with 73 followed by Lynne Lamrock with 75 and Casey Trevithick, 76.

Positions after 2 rounds of the ladies 3-round championships are Gross - Sandy Cook 169 1 shot ahead of Casey Trevithick. Nett - Helen Tickle 142, 2 shots ahead of Libby Lennon.
