Rule Clarification. Playing holes in consecutive order.

With exception to "Shotgun" and "Two tiered start" competitions, holes must be played in consecutive order (1-9 and 10-18) for all Saturday & Sunday Men's/Medley competitions. Local rule allows the exception for RSM Social Golfers to play the remaining 6 holes (in consecutive order) to qualify for the 18 hole

medley competition. (Full green fees apply)

Penalty for breach of rule is disqualification.
