Peter Lane had an excellent month taking out the vets Monthly Mug with a near record breaking 3-round total of 114.

John Henderson won the **Super vets** section in a countback with Don Sims.

Julie McRae was the winner of **Wednesday's ladies stableford** with a score of 33 points. The wet course meant little run and low scores. Helen Edwards and Julie Clark were next with 30 points.
