**Tuesday** - is the men's Vets comp with an 8:30 start and Super Vets starting at 10:30. Vets will play the bottom 9 twice.

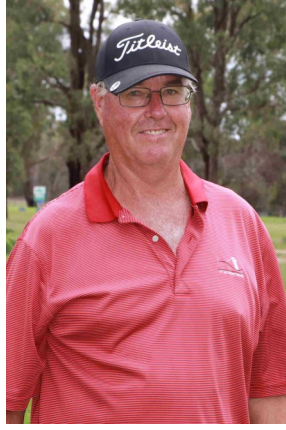
**Wednesday** - The ladies play their KENO 2 person ambrose qualifier. 9am start.
