The winners on the day were Helen Edwards and Cath Lane. They finished with nett 69 giving them a 36-hole total of 140 and the title of Club 4BBB stroke champions for 2025. Bronwyn Thorley and Helen Lockwood were runners-up with 142. Leonie Davison & Casey Trevithick and Denise Bryant & Anne Peters deserve mention for their effort in hanging in for the 18 holes.

Thursday's 12-hole comp washed out as was the Friday's ladies comps.
