Some joy on the course - 24 ducklings enjoying the course during the wet.

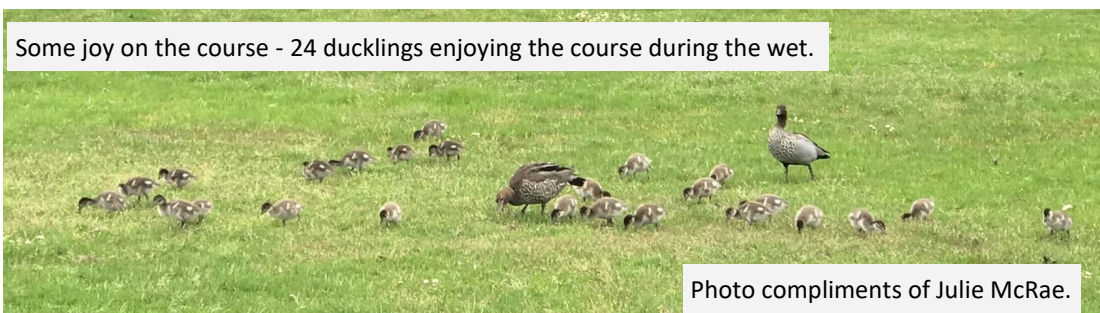
