Don Sims won the **Super Vets 9-hole comp on Tuesday**.

The ladies played an **18-hole stableford on Wednesday**. Bronwyn Thorley won in a countback with Judy Ditton when each finished with 36 points. Julie Clark and Helen Lockwood were next with 35's. Then came Di Shadlow, Sandra Williams, Sandy Cook and Libby Lennon. Each finished with 34 points.

The Thursday 12-hole comp was won by Gary Lamrock with 29 points - an improvement on his 23 for 18 holes on Tuesday 😊. Brian Winmill and Greg Brabant were next with 28's. Nearest the pin was Ken Luxford and Kevin Campbell, in his comeback game, won the putting - apparently his new hip is allowing a better follow through.
