The **ladies played the final round of their club championships on Wednesday.** Sandy Cook started the day 3 shots clear of Casey Trevithick. She went on to win the championship trophy with rounds of 83, 82 and 83 for a total of 248. This was Sandy's 2nd Inverell ladies championship having first won it in 2020. After producing solid scores of 84 for rounds 1 and 2, Casey fell short on the last day to finish in 2nd place with 255.

41 players hit off in **Sunday's Medley Stableford.** Gary Sharpe was the winner with 38 points. Tristan Irwin and Clayton pollock were next with 36. Mary Schofield and Jono Alliston finished with 35 and they were followed by 6 players with 34. Tristan Irwin recorded an eagle on the 15th.

The weeks competitions

The Ladies Open 4BBB comes up May 29



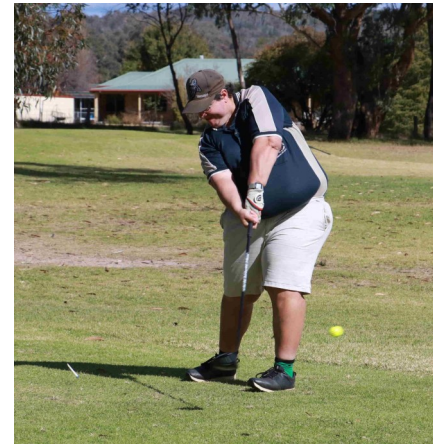

3Ball rules for Saturday May 25

Rules

A team consists of 3 players.

Each player's tee shot must be used 6 TIMES.

Each player tees off.

One tee shot is then selected from where all 3 players play their second shot within one club length of where the selected tee shot finished. (except on the green where putts are played within six inches or 15cm from the selected tee shot).

All 3 players then play out the hole with their own ball and continue to play it from where ever it finishes after each shot.

The rest of the game is played as per the rules of golf.

Scoring

Each team MUST score the other team's card when played in groups of six.

Recording each player's 6 tee shots as they are used.

If the team elect to use the tee shot of the player with the lowest handicap then only the BEST score of the three players is recorded for that hole.

If the team elect to use the tee shot of the second lowest handicap then the best TWO scores are recorded for that hole.

If the team elect to use the tee shot of the player with the highest handicap then all 3 scores are recorded for that hole.

The team that records the most number of stableford points over 18 holes is declared the winner.
